

<b>FACTS</b>	<b>WHAT DOES MONEYLION OF OHIO LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?</b>	
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security number and income</li> <li>• Account balances and payment history</li> <li>• Transaction or loss history and employment information</li> </ul> <p>When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>	
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons MoneyLion of Ohio LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does MoneyLion of Ohio LLC Protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>We also maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards such as computer virus protection software, firewalls, and a 128 bit Secure Socket Layer. Only authorized employees have access.</p>
How does MoneyLion of Ohio LLC Collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Give us your income information</li> <li>• Provide employment information</li> <li>• Provide account information</li> <li>• Give us your contact information</li> <li>• Show your driver's license</li> </ul>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you.</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Financial and nonfinancial companies related by common ownership or control.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>MoneyLion of Ohio LLC does not share with any affiliates at this time.</i></li> </ul>
Non-affiliates	<p>Financial and nonfinancial companies not related by common ownership or control.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Non-affiliates we may share with can include collection agencies, lenders, tax preparers, prepaid card providers, banks, debit card companies.</i></li> </ul>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Joint marketing partners include lenders, banks, prepaid card companies, debit card companies, institutions that promote our products.</i></li> </ul>
